Meetings are a necessary part of a large organization and you will work with other members of the Board to prepare for, and attend each of the quarterly Board meetings and the annual meeting of the Association. A key role for the Vice-president is the development of partnerships with other organizations that are involved in related activities. You will also sit on, or chair, Board committees. The Vice-president is seen as the future replacement for the President so you can use this opportunity to develop the skills you will need if you decide to take on greater responsibilities.

This is an opportunity to test your skills in a volunteer management position and to share your knowledge and experience with a wider audience.
